

Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work

A 8 hour Blended Learning Qualification covering emergency responses relating to accidents, incidents and emergencies in a place of work

Who is this qualification for?

This qualification is aimed at learners who wish to become emergency first-aiders in the workplace. This qualification meets the requirements for training emergency first-aiders in those organisations that have identified a need for staff to be trained to this level within their first-aid needs assessment.

How long will it take?

To complete this qualification learners should expect to undertake 8 hours of learning, with 2 hours of this session being completed independently through our Blended learning format. The remaining hours require a 6 hours attendance at a face to face practical training session

What does the course cost?

Topics covered

The qualification covers knowledge such as the roles and responsibilities of the first aider and how to assess an incident. The qualification also covers first aid skills in CPR and use of an AED, providing first aid to a casualty who is choking and dealing with external bleeding and hypovolemic shock
